AgapéCare Cradle is a specialized nonprofit funeral provider. We have adopted policies that we believe best meet the needs of the families we serve. These policies are explained in this brochure.

Funeral and Memorial Services and Supplies

AgapéCareSM Cradle services and funeral supplies are explained in this brochure. Donors and volunteers work together with us to provide these items for you. Although you may never meet these people, please know each one cares deeply about you during this sad time. ****The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected. AgapéCare Cradle will provide funeral services and supplies to you whether or not you are able to pay.** Please consider paying something if you are able to. You may designate AgapéCare Cradle as a memorial honoring the memory of your baby. Memorial donations and other public contributions help us to provide for more families who need our specialized services.

The dollar amount listed beside each item listed under **AgapéCare Supplies** represents AgapéCare Cradle's approximate cost to obtain the item for you. **Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff** includes all services AgapéCare Cradle provides immediately and for one year following your loss. We will give you an itemized statement, however you will not receive a bill for our program services & supplies that are listed in this brochure. ****You may ask for or decline any item (s) on this list except Basic Services.** We will file insurance if applicable.

Planning your baby's service can be a healing and memorable experience. We will answer your questions honestly and to the best of our ability. We will pray for you and your family.

- Basic Services (\$2500) **Basic Services** includes a complete set of remembrance items made specially to honor the life of your precious baby; photographs, hand/foot moldings, clothing, bookmarks, etc., **** conducting the arrangements conference, securing necessary permits, sheltering of remains, coordinating with the cemetery or other third parties and overhead.** Basic Services also includes supportive contacts following your baby's service. You may choose any / all services listed below:
- Transportation of deceased (Sedgwick County)
- Embalming and Restoration **** Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial. Please note: If you are seeking immediate cremation or immediate burial without any other services, most standard mortuaries can meet your needs. We can assist transfer to a standard mortuary if you desire a simple final disposition without any other services.**
- Embalming may be required in some circumstances, for example if you desire your baby's body to be transported to another state for burial, because embalming is required to transport a deceased person across state lines. We will not bill you for embalming services we provide.
- Cremation
- Use of staff/facilities for Visitation, Viewing Funeral, Graveside and / or Memorial Service

AgapéCareSM Supplies

- Casket (\$300)
- Urn (\$50)
- Outer Burial Container (\$150) ***In most areas of the country, state or local law does not require that you buy a container to surround the casket in the grave. However, many cemeteries require that you have such a container so the grave will not sink in. Either a grave liner or burial vault will satisfy these requirements.*
- Printed Items (\$65) - Baby Memory Book or Signature Register, Memorial Folders, Prayer Cards
- Remembrance gifts

OTHER EXPENSES

Services and supplies listed below are commonly needed with funeral, burial and / or cremation arrangements. Fees and policies vary between outside companies, such as cemeteries, florists, newspaper obituary departments, etc.

AGAPECARE DOES NOT PROVID FOR “OTHER EXPENSES” LISTED BELOW

- Cemetery Space
 - Open/Close grave
 - Newspaper Obituary (extra days in print, etc.)
 - Funeral escort services
 - Use of special vehicles (limousine, etc.)
 - Flowers
 - Transportation outside Sedgwick county
 - Tent & Chairs set-up fee (if cemetery does not provide with open/close/space cost)
 - Expenses billed to transport remains (freight, air fare)
 - Permanent Grave Marker
 - Forwarding of remains to another funeral home will require payment for fees billed to AgapéCare Cradle by the receiving funeral home &/or transport carriers.
